Neighborhood Revitalization NYC

- For households who are not eligible/did not register for Build it Back.
- Comprehensive structural and non-structural repairs up to \$80,000.
- Prioritizes low- and moderate-income households.

EmPower NY

- For households below 60% State Median Income (eligible for SNAP or TANF)
- FREE energy saving measures which may include a new high-efficiency boiler, hot water heater, refrigerator, lighting and airsealing & insulation

Heating Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

- For households below 60% State Median Income (eligible for SNAP or TANF)
- For boiler repair/replacement: apply in person at-
